2025 Award Pillars & Criteria

ABOUT THE AWARD

The George C. Delp Award is presented annually to a resident or business of Lancaster County who has made a significant contribution to the agricultural community. The individual/business must exemplify an outstanding dedication and commitment to preserving and enhancing agriculture in Lancaster County.

Deadline for Nomination: September 26th, 2025. The award will be presented at the 2025 Agriculture Industry Banquet on November 20, 2025.

AWARD PILLARS & CRITERIA

INDUSTRY LEADERSHIP & ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Demonstrates leadership within the agriculture industry through vision, mentorship, and innovation, while achieving professional excellence and recognition.

Examples could include:

- Leading a farm or agricultural business through innovative practices
- Mentoring others in the industry or spearheading collaborative projects
- Receiving awards, certifications, or industry recognition
- Serving on professional boards, trusteeships, or successfully managing initiatives

COMMUNITY SERVICE & IMPACT

Shows meaningful involvement in the Lancaster County community, investing time, resources, or expertise to make a positive impact.

Examples could include:

- Volunteer efforts or philanthropic support
- Organizing programs benefiting the local community or agriculture
- Involving others in community service initiatives

CHAMBER INVOLVEMENT

Supports and strengthens the Lancaster Chamber through active participation, leadership, and promotion of Chamber programs and initiatives.

Note: While this criterion has less influence on the final decision, it recognizes the nominee's support of Chamber programs and initiatives.
